Dear Sir,

Trawler "PHYLLISIA".

The Committee have now had before them the report of survey held on this trawler at Plymouth from October 1946 to June 1947, from which it is noted that the Special Survey on hull and machinery has been completed.

The Surveyor has furnished a plan of the pumping arrangements, in connection with the re-conversion of the ship for fishing purposes and it is found that at some time a 1½" stop cock connecting the bilge and feed water suction mains has been fitted. This, however, is not in accordance with the Society's Rules, and should be removed at the earliest opportunity.

In the circumstances the Committee have assigned a notation of S.S. Ply - 6,47 (Dr) in respect of the hull, but it is not proposed to record the Special Survey notation for the machinery until the above mentioned stop cock has been dispensed with, and I shall be glad to learn what arrangements you are able to make in this matter.

I enclose a Certificate for the hull notation mentioned above.
