Nature of Survey

REPAIRS TO ENGINES AND BOILERS DUE TO DAMAGE THROUGH

This vessel has been in Admiralty Service.

LMC now held.

Screw shaft now examined.

General repairs effected to the main and auxiliary machinery including skimming of the crank shaft journals, and remetalling of bearings.

IT IS SUBMITTED that this vessel is eligible for the Record * LMC 6.47.

The Surveyors have recommended a notation of S 10.46.

The vessel has been under survey since 10.46 and IT IS SUBMITTED for consideration whether a later date might be assigned.

It is concluded that ~~any~~ alterations to the pumping arrangements ~~now~~ effected ~~in the machinery and~~ ~~will~~ comply with the Rules, but the Surveyor should confirm this.
