Dear Sir,

With reference to your letter of the 20th instant, respecting the re-classification survey now held on the steam trawler "LOUGHRIGG" ex "ETTRICK" at Fleetwood, I have to inform you in reply to your enquiry regarding the fee to be charged for this survey that it is considered that in addition to the ordinary fee for Special Survey No.3 a charge of £5 should be made for the re-classification survey of the hull and machinery, making in all a combined fee of £21.

I have to add that it is considered that this amount may be divided as follows - £13 to be charged for the survey of the hull and £8 for the machinery.
