

The generator is one of a series of 22 similar machines intended for installation on board various vessels classed or intended for classification with this Society.

The machine was subjected to the following abbreviated test:-

Short run at full load
50 % overload for 1 min.
High voltage dielectric test.
Insulation resistance test.

The results of the above tests were satisfactory and are as recorded on the Makers' Test Certificate attached hereto, the temperature rises indicated being those obtained during satisfactory type tests carried out on Machine No.40517 on the 14th May, 1954.


The Machine was examined in finished condition and, as far as could be seen, found to be soundly constructed from good materials


