

LAID-UP "EL FLAMINGO" TO BE 'TOWED TO THE TEES

NEWCASTLE, Wednesday

After being laid up in the Tyne for more than two years the 8,420-ton-d.w. tanker *El Flamingo* is due to leave either to-night or to-morrow for the Tees where it is understood she will be converted for sand and gravel dredging (LLOYD'S LIST, Apr. 15).

Trustee Secretaries, Ltd., London, the owners, have no comment to make on this but it is learned that the vessel has been given a berth at Middlesbrough, to enable conversion to be made.

Earlier this month she was moved to Palmers Hebburn works of Vickers, Ltd., Shipbuilding Group, for drydocking and overhaul before making passage to the Tees.
