I have surveyed the above ship in accordance with the Rules for Annual & Docking Surveys and Condition of Class (Equipment).

The items now surveyed are detailed on this report. All were found or placed in good condition unless otherwise stated.

Wear & Tear Repairs

Rudder lifted and all four gudgeons rebushed, and pintles built up as necessary, and machined true.

Condition of Class- SRL No.231

Eleven new lengths (166 fms) of 1 1/4" stud link cable now supplied, details as per Rpt.8(Eq) and nine lengths (135 fms) of untested cable (supplied 5,64) removed, and returned ashore.

It is submitted that the condition of class regarding these cables may now be deleted.

"Indented shell plates Nos.5 and 6 (s.s.) from fwd. in 2nd below sheer to be kept under observation".

These plates specially examined and found to continue efficient.

I recommend that this ship remain as classed with ~~xxxxxx~~ fresh record of dry docking 3,65, and without condition regarding chain cables and the notation of SS 11,63 to be now given as previously recommended.
