This is to Certify that I have surveyed part of the machinery of the S.S. "AGHIOS NICOLAOS" 757 gross tons of Piraeus, for Steam Pipe Survey and condition of class referring to Main Boiler, as she lay afloat at this port on the 12th July, 1965 and subsequently,

and that all my recommendations have been carried out to my satisfaction. I am reporting accordingly and recommending to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping that the machinery classification should be retained and the following

survey records assigned S.P.S. 7,65 now and M.B.S. 3,65 when the survey has been completed, as previously recommended, subject to the main boiler port combustion chamber back plate being dealt with as necessary by the end of November, 1965 and to all other outstanding conditions of class being dealt with as previously recommended.

Parts now examined:—

Main Steam Pipes including saturated pipes in boiler smoke box.

To complete the Main Boiler Survey the outstanding condition of class remains to be dealt with.
