



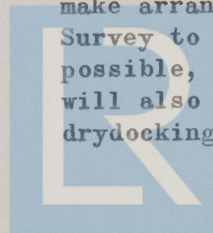
ANSWER



Date:— 29th December 1964.

Owners advise that new chain cable has not yet been received from the manufacturers although it is expected any day now. We are given to understand that they have a drydock reservation in Piraeus for February of next year and that the new cable will definitely be placed on board at that time.

The Owners have been requested to make arrangements for the Main Boiler Survey to be carried out as soon as possible, but it seems likely that this will also be done at the time of the drydocking.
