Whilst this vessel was undergoing anchor trials in the River Clyde yesterday some difficulty was experienced with the windlass, the cable shackles became jammed in the cable lifters.

The heads of the pins of the shackles appeared rather full and the builders have arranged to have these slightly reduced and the windlass re-tried on the vessels arrival in the River Medway to where she is now proceeding.

I will be glad if you will give the case the necessary attention on her arrival on Thursday the 12th. inst.
