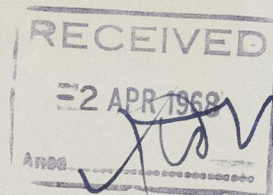

In reply to your classing letter dated 18th March, 1968 in connection with our Report No. 19218, we would inform you that we were only requested to attend on board this vessel whilst she lay afloat at Kobe, to examine one bower anchor and short length of chain cable which had been placed on board, and which was stated to be replacement for that lost at Durban on 29th October, 1967.

The owners have stated that they propose to carry out the testing of the 2 lengths of cable recommended by our Yokohama Surveyors, at the next dry docking.
