With reference to your letter of the 17th instant, forwarding for reference the plans of the S.S. "HAZELPARK" and "HEATHPARK", together with a letter from Mr. Martell and Mr. Edgar detailing the alterations at present being carried out, I now return herewith four of the plans in question. The boiler plan is being returned under separate cover.

At the same time I have to add that the remarks of Mr. Martell and Mr. Edgar have been carefully noted, and I have to thank them for their attention in the matter. It may be observed that the Representative of prospective buyers of a duplicate vessel was informed in this Office that the stiffening in the double bottom under the heels of the widely spaced pillars would, in the event of the vessel being submitted for classification, require to be to the satisfaction of the Society's Surveyors.
