Dear Sirs,

With reference to my letter of yesterday's date respecting the case of the ex-German Steamer "BETZDORF", I have to send herewith a preliminary first entry/machinery/report which has been prepared in this Office, and with regard thereto I am directed to inform you that, provided the particulars of the machinery be as given on the report; the engines and boilers be opened out, examined, and found to be in good order and safe working condition; the shafting be found sound and free from defects; the pumping arrangements be in order and in accordance with the requirements of the Rules, the machinery of this vessel will be accepted, in this instance, for a working pressure of 185 lbs per square inch, and a record of LMC (with date) without the distinguishing mark * be assigned.

For your information I enclose copies of letters, dated the 18th April and 24th instant, regarding the pumping arrangements of the sister vessels "HAZELPARK" and "HEATHPARK".
