In addition, I would remind you that in the cases of the "AMADEO" and "ANTARTICO", First Entry Reports on the machinery and electrical equipment are also required.

In the case of the "AMADEO" as stated in my classing letter of the 9th June last, plans of the machinery will be required, unless plans of identical machinery have already been submitted, in which case you should supply details.
