This CL-M-AV1 vessel was built in 1945 and classed / with the American Bureau of Shipping.

She is a sister vessel to the "MAULE" which was / classed 100A1 with this Society in 8.49.

It is stated that she was last examined in dry dock by a Surveyor to the American Bureau of Shipping in August 1949.

For further particulars regarding this case see correspondence.

The VALPARAISO Surveyor reports 3.50 the vessel afloat / and a satisfactory General Examination held with a view to later Classification with this Society.

The upper deck bulwarks have been extended. X

It is submitted the vessel is worthy to have the provisional class 100A1 (Classification Contemplated) and notation of "Examined 3.50" valid for 12 months assigned.
