With reference to your memorandum of the 17th August I would inform you that the Owners' proposal to carry out the Docking Survey, probably at Hong Kong, by the end of September, 1968, has been approved.

As, however, the vessel has not been examined in drydock by the Society's Surveyors since August 1966, and in view of the Hull conditions of class, as noted in the S.R.L. No.290 under "JULIANA", it is considered that the Docking Survey should not be deferred beyond the end of the present month.

I conclude that the Special and Auxiliary Boiler Surveys, due September and November, 1968 respectively, will be held and the CSM cycle brought up to date at the forthcoming drydocking.
