
In reply to the enquiry contained/your Classing Letter of the 20th inst., respecting the case of the Salvage Vessel "PRINCE SALVOR", our Report No. 52171, we beg to acquaint you that there are 4 intact bulkheads extending to the Upper Deck from side to side of the vessel at frames Nos. 9, 27, 69 and 89. There are 2 further watertight bulkheads at frames 47 and 102 which are not intact. A General Arrangement Plan indicating the positions and extent of the bulkheads and Arrangement of Double Bottom Tanks, with solid and bracket floors indicated, is enclosed.


We confirm that an Echo Sounding Device has been fitted in this vessel and the length of the forecastle should be given as 24 ft.


