A With reference to Hull Report No. 52171 on the Salvage Vessel "PRINCE SALVOR" (J.2516), I have now to inform you that the fees due for the supervision of the requirements of the specification in this case have been amended on the report in question from £111.8.0. to £105.0.0. in respect of the hull, to conform with the terms of the original arrangement made with the Director of Navy Contracts relating to specification fees.

These fees are not affected by the amendment in the Classification Fees, which are now computed on the basis of actual gross tonnage.

A claim has accordingly been rendered to the Director of Navy Accounts for the fees due, and, in due course, your account will be credited with the following sums -

Of the balance, the sum of £25.4.0. will be credited to the Newcastle account in respect of the machinery, and a similar sum to Sunderland account in respect of the boilers.

It is presumed that you will have arranged for the sum of £25.4.0. to be credited to the Sunderland account in due course, in respect of the Classification Survey of the boilers for this vessel, in accordance with the request contained in letter addressed to you by the Surveyors at that port on 29th January last.
