We are advised by the Owners that they are in receipt of a cable from the Master stating that there has been no opportunity to arrange for the requisite inspections to be carried out either at Hong Kong or Japan.

She sailed from Singapore on the 21st instant where she only called for bunkers and is now bound for Dakar where she is expected to arrive on the 30th November.

Due to unforeseen reasons the contemplated docking has not yet taken place. An opportunity will, however, be afforded to arrange for the outstanding survey matters to receive attention at Dakar where also the Aux. Boiler Survey will be held.
