ANSWER

With reference to your letter of the 25th May, it is concluded that the machinery condition of class will be dealt with at the same time as the anchor and chain cable when the vessel arrives at Ceuta, but your confirmation will be appreciated.

Date:— 18th June, 1964.

We are advised by the Owners that the requisite anchor and chain cable equipment was placed onboard during the vessel's recent call at Ceuta. As there is no Surveyor to this Society available in that port, arrangements will be made for the equipment to be verified at the first opportunity.

The ship is at present on a voyage to Cuba, and the Owners will revert to the matter as soon as they are in a position to state when and where the requisite inspections can be carried out.
