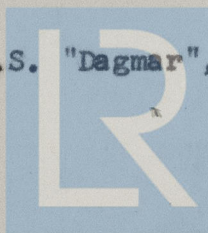
The Report of a survey held at Penang on the 10th April on account of loss of the port bower anchor and 4 lengths of chain cable, has now received the consideration of the Committee.
