A Special Survey (c) became due 8,66 and was commenced at Gen. 11,65 and subsequently advanced.

The portion of survey held consisted of the internal examination of F & A peak tanks and chain locker.

Following a cable from the New Orleans Surveyors regarding bottom damage repair the notation "to be broken up class suspended 8,66" was assigned.

The New Orleans Surveyors report (16.2.66) ship examined afloat and certain recommendations ~~were~~ made to allow the ship to proceed to Europe for repairs. These repairs were, however, not carried out and the Surveyors ~~should inform~~ this office as above.
