

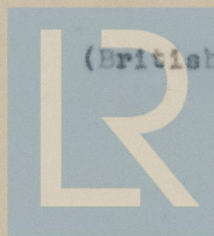

HONGKONG, Sept. 17.

The Panamanian Government has cancelled the registration of ships flying the Panamanian flag for having allegedly violated a decree ordering them to stay out of Chinese Communist ports. The Panamanian Consul-General in HongKong, Mario Guillen, said today. He said five companies registered in Panama have been black listed and will henceforth not be permitted to register any of their ships under the Panamanian flag.

The ships names were given by Guillen as the FAIRSIDE, KAIKORAL, SAGEN, STORBAY, VESST BAY, NAVIDAD, NORINA, ROMANTICO, MIRAMAR and WALTER ORBITAL. Guillen also said action is contemplated against another ship, the WILLA, belonging to the Pacific Union Steamship Company, on the same grounds.
