Dear Sirs,

I duly received your letter of the 3rd instant respecting the steamer "VEST BAY" which was read to the Committee today in association with your Report No.10268 on this ship.

The circumstances of this case as detailed by you are appreciated, and the Committee have agreed to the two round trip voyages to Canton before submitting the ship to Special Survey.

Having regard, however, to her age and to the fact that the voyages proposed are in sheltered waters, they trust it will be possible for the Owners to arrange for the survey to be held on completion of the charter at Hong Kong.

If they still wish to proceed to Japan for survey a further general examination will be necessary before undertaking this voyage.
