Dear Sirs,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 30th ultimo respecting the Motorship "MORSKA WOLA", the contents of which have been noted, and in reply I have to acquaint you that in the circumstances no objection will be taken to the Special Survey being postponed until September next.

With regard to the penultimate paragraph of your above mentioned letter I have to inform you that the Donkey Boiler Survey was not dealt with at Hamburg as owing to a misunderstanding the boiler was not prepared for survey, it was however examined under steam and appeared to be in a satisfactory condition. The Donkey Boiler Survey therefore became due at the end of March last as stated in my letter of the 30th April last. No objection, however, will be taken to this inspection being deferred until the Special Survey is carried out in September next.

In connection with the alignment of the port generator engine crank shaft, I have to say that this matter is being referred to the Society's Surveyor at Algiers and upon the receipt of his reply a further communication will be addressed to you.
