WEAR AND TEAR REPAIRS.

The items now surveyed are detailed on this report. All were found or placed in good condition unless otherwise stated.

WEAR & TEAR REPAIRS:

Now Done: One doubler plate welded to shell p. s. of E.R. where water dripping from engine driven bilge pump had caused local wastage in shell.

About 8 feet of deck plating alongside E.R. skylight casing p.s. part cropped and renewed.

Deckhouse plating p.s. in way of steampipes part cropped up 18" and renewed.

Both latter repairs hose tested on completion and found satisfactory. Sundry minor repairs carried out.

S.R.L. APPENDIX No.16:

Indents in sheerstrake and strake below (p & s ) examined and considered no action required. The plates remain efficient.

I recommend that this ship remain as classed with/~~without~~ fresh record of dry docking 7,65 and notation of S.S. 8,65 without special condition.
