Dear Sirs,

I duly received your letter of the 30th ultimo regarding the steamer "LINDEAN" ex "YELLOWHAMMER", and in reply have to say that as the casualty notation assigned in this case, namely, "Damaged by Stranding 4,48." automatically cancelled the vessel's class you should recommend for reclassification a fresh date of Special Survey for entry in the Register Book.

As regards fees you should charge one and a half times the Special Survey fee on hull and machinery in addition to an adequate damage repair fee.
