I have surveyed the above-named ship in accordance with the Rules for DOCKING AND ANNUAL SURVEYS.

WEAR AND TEAR REPAIRS

(Note:— Shell plates numbered from forward)

Bottom shell plate A6, Starb., in way of no.1 centre tank, part doubled.

Bottom shell plate A7, port, in way of no.2 centre tank, part doubled (found fractured).

It was recommended that the above plates be renewed, but the Owners requested that doublers be accepted. The repairs now done are considered efficient but it is recommended that these plates be specially examined and dealt with as necessary at the next dry docking.

Bottom shell plate E7, starb., in way of Midship Pump Room doubled in way of local corrosion (holed). This plate is considered efficient meantime but it is recommended that it be specially examined and dealt with as necessary at next dry docking.

Minor repairs also effected.

Bottom shell plates A6 (Starb.), A7 (Port) and E7 (Starb.) all from forward to be specially examined and dealt with as necessary at next dry docking.

S.R.L. APPENDIX No. 21:— Shell plates H14(P), J14 and 15, K15(S) indented - examined and found to continue efficient.
