This is to Certify that I have surveyed part of the machinery of the **M.S. CAMPECHE, 6382** Gross tons of Tarragona for **Drydocking and auxiliary boiler survey**

and that all my recommendations have been carried out to my satisfaction. I am reporting accordingly and recommending to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping that the machinery classification should be retained and the following survey records assigned. **ABS 3,68** subject to any outstanding conditions of class being dealt with as previously recommended.

Parts now examined:—

Propellers and all outside fastenings.
Port and starboard auxiliary boilers internally and externally with mountings and safety valves and the safety valves of both boilers adjusted under steam.
Oil burning system and remote controls.

NOTE. The safety valves of both boilers have been adjusted such that the working pressure shall not exceed 8kg/cm².
