the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of Messrs. La Sociedad Española de Construcción Naval of Matagorda, attend at their works to examine one ballast pump type vertical double acting 9" x 11" x 10" intended for Messrs. Union Naval de Levante Valencia. Vessel N<sup>o</sup>. 22

This pump was examined during construction and on completion. The steam and pump ends were tested by hydraulic pressure to 320 lbs and 100 lbs respectively and found tight and sound.
