



Dear Sir:

With reference to your letter to this office dated 16th December, 1963, ref. NH/CB/R in which it is stated that the Committee are agreeable to a General Examination of this ship being held on dry dock but that the period of postponement granted for the Special Survey would depend upon the condition of the ship as found and reported upon at this examination.

It will be noted that Halifax Report 8389 recommends the postponement of Hull and Machinery Special Surveys for the full year and this has been done because of the satisfactory condition of the external shell and because of the extensive repairs now carried out to the after peak structure.

The Owners were quite insistent that our interim certificate would state that the full year of postponement had been granted and consequently this information has been written into our Certificates B. & B.1.

It is hoped that the above action will meet with your approval.
