Steamers "ARGUAL", "OROTAVA" and "TELDE"
Motorship "CUBAHAMA"

I acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 26th ultimo respecting the withdrawal of class of the above named ships, the contents of which are noted.

With regard to the case of the Steamer "ARGUAL", it is thought well to inform you that the present practice when disclassing ships either L.R. or B.C. is to use only Lloyd's Register symbols. The case has accordingly been submitted to the Committee here who have given instructions for the class to be expunged with a Red Line, which they conclude is equivalent to the action the American Committee had in mind in assigning a minute of "Disclassified B.S* 1,54".

In the remaining cases of the Steamers "OROTAVA", "TELDE" and Motorship "CUBAHAMA", the Committee have given instructions for the classes to be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at the Owners' request.

I shall be glad if you will inform the Owners accordingly.
