
Referring to my cable of the 25th ultimo and your cable reply of the 26th respecting the steamer "ARGUAL", I may say that the Mobile Surveyor's report No. 2685 has been dispatched to you with the classings of the 10th instant. The American Committee assigned the minute "Disclassed BS+ 1-54", subject, of course, to confirmation by the General Committee.

Arising out of that case we received a letter from the Owners withdrawing classification in the cases of their other vessels, "OROTAVA", "TELDE", and "CUBAHAMA", and I enclose a copy of their letter of the 25th ultimo on the subject.
