Dear Sir;- Steamer "KEYSHEY"

With reference to your letter addressed to the Owners of this Ship, and forwarded to them through this Office, concerning the withdrawal of War-Time Concessions in the supply of Anchor and Cable Equipment, the Owners have now informed us that the "KEYSHEY" has 90 fathoms of Cable on one Bower Anchor and 105 fathoms on the other Anchor.

The Ship is classed for Great Lakes and Gulf of St. Lawrence Service and for such ships it is British Corporation practice to accept a total of 180 fathoms of Anchor Cable.
