With reference to classing letter dated 29th November 1949 report No. 7863 regarding this ship please note that due to a typographical error the vessel's class is shown as B.S.\* on the above mentioned report instead of B.S.\*( Great Lakes and Gulf of St. Lawrence Service.

Consequently the indented shell plating due to canalling is merely noted without any recommendation unless the surveyor considers that the seaworthiness of the vessel for this service is impaired. No recommendation was necessary in this case.

The cable length for vessels engaged on Great Lakes and Gulf Service is 180 fathoms

The masts and rigging were fully examined by the Government inspection service and the surveyor and as stated should read " examined from aloft".
