

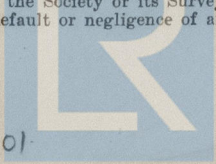
*Surveyed the Steel Sc. Steamer "SPALMATORI" 7199 tons gross
