the undersigned Surveyor to this Society did at the request of Messrs. E. N. Mackley & Co., Gateshead, attend at their Works on 3rd July 1940 and subsequently at the Works of Messrs. Clarke, Chapman & Co. Ltd., Gateshead, for the purpose of inspecting one Centrifugal Circulating Pump made by Messrs. E. N. Mackley & Co. to the order of Messrs. Amos & Smith Ltd., Hull, Order No. 6330, and intended for Admiralty Contract No. J.5085.

The Pump is driven by an enclosed forced lubrication vertical steam Engine having one Cast Iron Steam Cylinder 6" dia. by 3½" stroke.

The Cylinder and Valve Chest were tested at 400 lbs. per square inch water pressure with satisfactory results.

On completion the Pump and Engine were examined running under steam and found satisfactory. Spare Gear has been fitted in place.

So far as could be seen the workmanship and materials employed in the construction of this Pump are good.
