



afloat and berthed at "B" shed, on the 9th February 1965, for the purpose of  
ascertaining the nature and extent of damage to the port propeller in  
consequence of contacting the wharf when leaving Beira, at 0705 hours of the  
8th February 1965.

I have surveyed the above ship and found the trailing edge of one  
blade of the abovementioned propeller turned about six inches.

I recommend the vessel remain as classed, with further examination
