Continuous Survey Machinery

We enclose herewith a letter dated 25th January 1968 which has been received from the Superintendent Engineer of the above Trawler Company concerning a proposal to carry out Continuous Survey of Machinery on a number of their steam trawlers, the omissions from this scheme, i.e., Arctic Buccaneer, Arctic Outlaw, Arctic Hunter, and Arctic Crusader being trawlers which will be scrapped in the foreseeable future.

Accompanying the letter is a directive dated 20th October 1967 from the Hull Steam Trawlers Mutual Insurance Co. giving a list of items which are to be examined at set intervals on their behalf and I think it well to add that these requirements are to be strictly adhered to, no extensions of time being permitted.

With these requirements in mind the Owners have drawn up a list of their proposals for Continuous survey and these appear to be reasonable.

A copy of the Owners survey list for 1968 is also enclosed.

Since receiving this Owners letter a further discussion has been held with the Superintendent. He has agreed to complete the surveys which become due on the Arctic Avenger in 7,68, and carry out as much continuous survey as possible on the others and trusts that when the hull special survey is carried out any outstanding item of CS will be accepted from the previous survey (provided it was carried out within twelve months of last survey date) so that the Hull survey and CS dates

will coincide.

Furthermore in the case of the "Arctic Freebooter" it is hoped that a General Examination for postponement of Special Survey will be granted if required in order to keep the S.S. and C.S. dates in line.

With regard to the last paragraph of the Owners letter it has now been decided not to proceed with CSH.

We would add that we consider that these Owners will use every endeavour to carry out their surveys at the due time and we shall be glad to have your comments on these proposals in due course.
