TAILSHAFT.


The tailshaft keyway conforms to C.1102 of the Society's Rules, was crack detected and found in good order, the Owners however do not request a four yearly period of Survey.

S.R.L.No.252:-

Superheater header and elements to be specially examined, when refitted.
(See Rpt.Hul.71326).

The Superheater headers have now been examined in way of division plate and found good and hydraulically tested to 600 p.s.i. and found good, the superheater elements have been renewed. The headers and elements have now been refitted to the boiler and I therefore submit that this item be deleted from the S.R.L.

The reason for repairs must be stated and those on account of damage, the alleged cause of which must be given, should be detailed separately from wear and tear repairs. State what action has been taken regarding items which are subjects of class.
