With reference to your classing letter of the 26th instant in respect of the trawlers "ST. BARTHOLOMEW" and "ST. MARK", Hull Reports Nos. 53377 and 53378, we beg to state that the capacities of the fresh water tank and boiler feed tank are 13 and 22 tons respectively and it is regretted that these particulars were not given on our reports.

The thickness of the soft nose stem plating is .50" and not .40" as inadvertently stated and we shall be glad if you will be good enough to make the necessary amendment to our First Entry Reports.
