With reference to your letter of the 23rd August last, the Committee have now had before them a report from the Society's Surveyors in London, from which it is noted that this vessel has been examined in dry dock and the requirements of Special Survey and Annual Survey have been complied with.

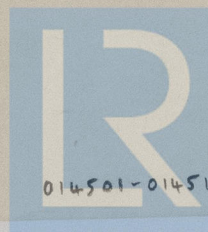
The Surveyors report that the screw shaft was drawn for examination and corrosion was found in way of the port oil gland. They recommend that the shaft be again drawn for examination before the end of August next.

This recommendation has been confirmed by the Committee, who have continued the vessel's class, with appropriate notations of Survey, subject to this matter receiving attention by the time stated, and it is concluded you will arrange accordingly.
