
With reference to your letter of 13th September 1963 notifying us of the classing of the above ships we regret that the breaking loads for the mooring ropes were incorrectly reported and should be as follows:-

"POLISI 504" 26mm 5,900 Kgs., 45mm 14,800 Kgs.
"POLISI 505" 26mm 6,000 Kgs., 45mm 14,900 Kgs.

We also wish to confirm that the pontoon hatch covers were built in accordance with the approved plans.

With regard to the sister ship "POLISI 506" the breaking loads for the mooring ropes should read for 26mm rope; 5,900 Kgs. and for 45mm rope; 14,800 Kgs. and the pontoon hatch covers were also built in accordance with the approved plans.
