Nature of Survey

The Hull Surveyors report this vessel placed in dry dock and the bottom examined and coated.

The forecastle has been lengthened, side houses extended at after end of bridge on quarter deck, a watertight door fitted to the bulkhead between the hold and the cross bunker and other alterations carried out to the Surveyors' satisfaction.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey 3,26, as recommended.
