The first entry reports in connection with the Special Survey carried out on the vessel for Classification were forwarded airmail to London on 1st instant.

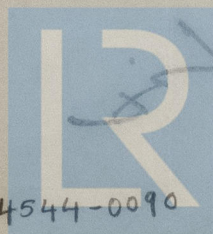

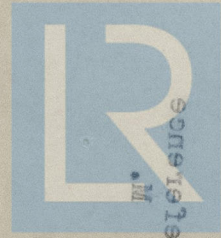
