Reverting to your letter of the 17th December last, I have to inform you that in reply to enquiry I am informed by Lloyds Agents at Beyrout that the Boiler Survey was not completed during the vessel's stay at that port.

In the circumstances, I shall be glad to learn, for the information of the Committee, what early arrangements are proposed to be made for the inspection in question to be completed by the examination under working conditions of the oil fuel remote controls and steam smothering arrangements and the adjustment of all safety valves.
