I have to acquaint you that the report of the survey carried out by the Society's Surveyors at Grimsby in May/September last on the steamer "WILLIAM HOMAN" has now received the consideration of the Committee.

In consequence of this inspection, the vessel has been classed "100A1" with appropriate survey notations subject to the bilge pumping arrangements being brought up to Rule requirements.

In this connection, I may say that the valve lids and extended spindles in No.1 hold remain to be dealt with and an additional 2" bilge suction to be fitted in No. 2 hold.

Classification certificates for hull and machinery will be forwarded to you shortly.
