I duly received your letter of the 17th instant respecting the case of the Steamer "ARGUS" ex "MINNA", and have to confirm my cabled reply yesterday as per the enclosed translation.

With regard thereto, I shall be glad if you will kindly inform the Owners that before any survey for classification is held, it will be necessary for plans of midship section, profile and decks, the usual particulars of Engines, sizes of shafting, plans of pumping arrangements and of boilers to be forwarded to this Office for the consideration of the Committee.

I should add that the necessary instructions in regard to the requisite examination in drydock have been forwarded to the Society's Amsterdam Surveyors, who have been requested to charge a suitable fee for the services rendered.
