THIS IS TO CERTIFY that the undersigned surveyor to this Bureau did, at the request of the Owner, Waterman Steamship Company attend the steel screw steamer "RAPHAEL SEMMES" of Mobile, Ala. Official Number 242,074 on the 2nd day of October 1952, and subsequent dates, as she lay afloat at Pier 78 South, Philadelphia, Pa. in order to carry out an Annual Boiler Survey of the Port Boiler. For particulars see the report as follows:

1. The Port water tube boiler together with its super-heater was examined internally and externally and the mountings were examined and found or placed in satisfactory condition.
2. The safety valves were set under steam to relieve at 500# psi.

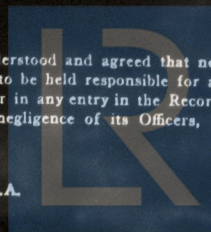
The Annual Boiler Survey is now complete.
