Mr. Bennett points out that through an oversight on the part of the Owners, the Society's Surveyors were not called in for this inspection, but they are taking steps to avoid this omission in the future.

It is submitted for consideration whether this Survey can be accepted, if so a notation of docking date 11.43 to be assigned.
