With reference to your query contained in the classing letter of March 2nd, the contents of your letter of the 15th January last have been the subject of correspondence with the New Orleans Surveyor.

In his latest letter the Surveyor points out that "the survey was as comprehensive as required for "SPECIAL SURVEYS TYPE 3" (par. 6.) The shell plating, frames, deck beams, bulkheads, etc. were bared for examination at representative points to ascertain condition and were found good excepting, of course, the wasted sections, stiffeners and angles in the chain locker which were renewed at this time. The whole of the scantlings are now considered to be in good condition."

In view of the withdrawal from class of this vessel as mentioned in my letter of the 12th March, it is not considered that any further action need be taken in the matter.
